 - Having a self-standing LIS resource is expensive and may not be budgeted year to year. It is hard to maintain, update, and support this program. This impacts the programs ability to provides learning/teaching on LIS specifically.
 - Employers are requesting students to be trained in LIS, which all agreed was beyond the scope of educating to minimally-competent MLPs.
